

"Faram has designed a series of solutions to ensure the separation and protection of people in workstations where safe interaction is required, according to the new social distance protocols."



They are designed in order to ensure the tightness of screens of different sizes and weights, starting from resistant and easy-to-clean materials, which do not scratch, dull or color change, due to exposure to sunlight or contact with chemical agents.

They are all **without gaskets**, as a receptacle for dirt, difficult to clean and at risk of deterioration with the use of aggressive chemicals. The gasket color also changes over time, if exposed to sunlight.






Freestanding screen W.O.W. with floor support

Self-supporting structure with aluminum profiles that support the glass. It can be placed next to existing desks or counters to protect the operator interacting with the public. It divides and protect the space. Available in transparent glass or with melamine panels.

Available with circular or linear bases.

- Modular.
- Stable and insurable on the floor.
- Can be placed side by side and attached to each other.
- Available in different widths.
- Equipped with holes of different sizes for documents or other objects passage.
- Support shelves available.
- Movable from one area to another, equipped with wheels.
- Variable heights, up to 2 meters.











Screen W.O.W. attached to the table

- Equipped with holes of different sizes for documents or other objects passage.












Corner screen W.O.W.

This corner version allows you to divide existing tables to create additional workstations protected by a screen that can be hooked to another desk, without drilling the existing top. The feet are equipped with non-slip material.

Suitable for meeting rooms, to create spaced and protected meetings or to obtain new workstations and allow more space.

Screen W.O.W. for counters

Designed to be easily adaptable to different situations of frontal interaction protection, such as in the case of reception, cashiers and counters of public or private entities.

Available in the version with brackets that can be attached to existing counters.

- Equipped with holes of different sizes for documents or other objects passage.
- Support shelves available.







Materials

Our structures are suitable for the use of materials with different characteristics. In the glass version, it is tempered and with rounded edges. It can also be transparent, with film or with etched serigraphy.

Glass is the most easily sanitized material, with high levels of resistance over time and recyclability, it can maintain its characteristics of transparency and healthiness, despite repeated cleaning cycles and no-stop use.
Glass is the material strongly recommended by Faram.
